



ABSTRACTS SUBMISSION GUIDELINES • PARIS ECHO 2023

The Organizing Committee and the Scientific Committee invite all stakeholders and researchers involved in the field of Cardiovascular Imaging to submit original works for commented posters and poster.

Clinical cases are not accepted.

A selection of the best posters will be presented by their author during the 2023 edition of the PARIS-ECHO Congress (3 minutes presentation followed by 3 minutes of questions), which will take place at the Palais des Congrès in Paris from May 31 to June 2, 2023.

Posters will also be displayed during the congress. We will ask the authors to be present in front of their poster during a defined time slot so that they can answer questions from participants. The best posters will be awarded.

A. AWARDS

Participate to the best posters prizes to have a chance to win a **check for €500!**

8 prizes will be awarded to the best posters presented by young fellows.

B. RULES

Abstract presented need to be original works; clinical studies are not accepted.

- **Communication's themes**

Your abstract should concern one of the following themes:

- 1) Cardiovascular multimodality imaging techniques
- 2) Vavular diseases, prostheses, endocarditis
- 3) Cardiomyopathies, heart failure, athletes, hypertension
- 4) Coronary and vascular diseases
- 5) Right heart, thoracic aorta, congenital heart diseases
- 6) Cardio Oncology

- **Language**

All abstracts must be submitted in English.

- **Declaration of interests**

You must indicate your potential conflicts of interest related to the study and theme of your abstract in the submission, and on your poster.



C. KEY DATES

The last date for submissions will be **February 6, 2023 at midnight**. All abstracts received after this date will not be reviewed.

The author will be informed to the decision of the Scientific Committee concerning his poster in **March 2023**.

Only authors who register for the Congress will be confirmed as abstract presenters.

D. SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

- 1) Register as an author and create an account. You may submit more than one abstract per account.
- 2) Indicate your abstract title.
- 3) Specify the theme of your abstract by choosing one of the **5 themes proposed**.
- 4) Indicate the progress of your abstract's status: **completed** or **in progress**.
- 5) Indicate your conflicts of interest related to the study and theme of your abstract.
- 6) Clearly indicate the name of the presenter, and then co-authors. The **Scientific Secretariat will need to contact the presenter**.
- 7) Enter your abstract **in English** in the text boxes provided for this purpose (please respect the ordre given: **Introduction, Methods, Results, Conclusion**).
- 8) Please do not enter more than **2000 characters**.
- 9) Save your abstract as a draft if you are not ready to submit it. When ready, submit your abstract.
- 10) **An email will immediately confirm that your abstract has been recorded by the system.**
- 11) To submit an additional abstract, connect directly to your account with your login and password.

E. EVALUATION PROCEDURE

Abstracts are reviewed and evaluated anonymously by the Scientific Committee, depending on the theme chosen for your abstract.

The author will be notified of the Scientific Committee's decision in **March 2023**.
